


#### Purpose

**ecopa** facilitates the exchange of scientific information, expertise and experience between national consensus platforms, industry, science, animal welfare and EU and government institutions.

**ecopa** organises conferences, seminars, publishes documents, collects and circulates information, supports scientific and educational initiatives.




#### **Criteria to be met by National Platforms**

- Acceptance of the "4-parties principle" and the 3R concept as a consensus in an individual country.
- Recognized legal organisation (statutes, by-laws, legal status, permanent address).
- Activities in the 3R area (promotion of the 3Rs, sponsoring programs, education, dissemination of information).
- Election/nomination of representatives to ECOPA in an open and democratic way. Members should be representatives of the 4 parties.
- Should provide information about their financial background.


The NARA in Norway already contains representatives from the 4 stakeholders, but should a regulatory body be the platform?

- Finland (200,000 animals)
  - State: 260,000
  - Fund: 130,000
- Denmark (300,000 animals)
  - Several projects, not least in cooperation with industry
